

Daniel Lepage c. SAAQ & al. (200-06-000172-141)
Hearing on the Merits Postponed (trial) – Winter 2022

- **This document concerns:**

Members of the class action entitled Daniel Lepage c. SAAQ et al., meaning any person who was arrested for operating a road vehicle while impaired and who has been denied a driver's licence, during the period from January 27, 2011 to December 31, 2016, following an unfavourable summary assessment or risk assessment.

- **Please note:**

The trial that was set to take place in Quebec City from September 21 to October 29, 2020 was postponed due to the current pandemic.

The trial (hearing on the merits) will now take place from February 7 to March 17, 2022, in Quebec City. You are obviously not required to attend.

- **What to do until then?**

We ask that you keep all supporting documents regarding the damages that you have likely incurred due to the SAAQ's refusal to issue your licence, such as costs for the installation and maintenance of the alcohol-ignition interlock device, comprehensive assessment fees, etc.
